Unlock Teaching Notes

Sage Business Cases is a global collection of proprietary, licensed, and commissioned cases that inspires researchers to develop their own best practices and prepare for professional success. This resource is accompanied by locked, instructor-only teaching notes that include suggested teaching strategies, target audience, and discussion questions with possible responses that can help facilitate classroom integration. You can typically access Sage Business Cases through your library's website—either via the A–Z database list or on a discipline-specific page. If you're unsure where to find it or need assistance locating your instructor verification code for teaching notes, please contact your library. Once you have your code and have authenticated through your institution's access, follow these steps to view the teaching notes:

- Click **My Profile**, located in the top right corner of every page, to sign in or create a new profile.
- Scroll down until you find the **Sage Business Cases Instructor Access** checkbox. Once this checkbox has been selected, a **Verification Code** field will appear.
- Input the instructor verification code that has been supplied by your library into the box and click **Save** at the bottom of the page. *This code is case sensitive.*

Please note that "Signed in" indicates that you are authenticated through your institutions access. Once you sign into your profile, your name will appear in the "MY PROFILE" box.

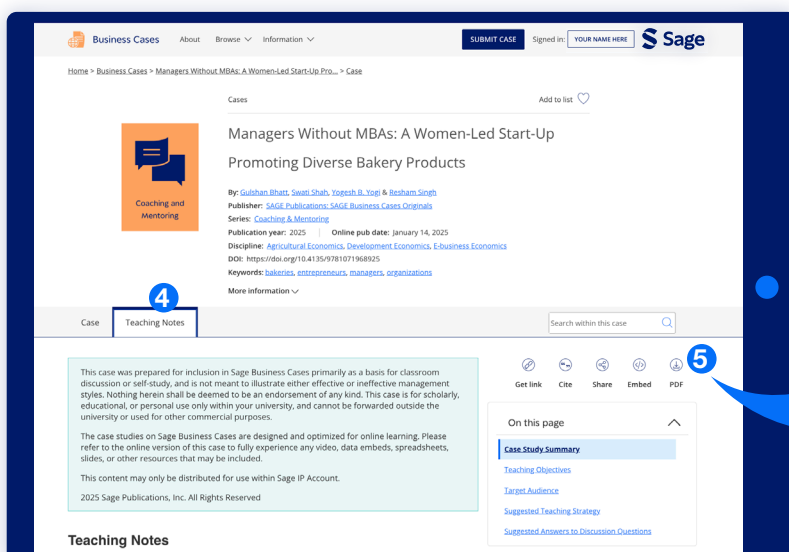
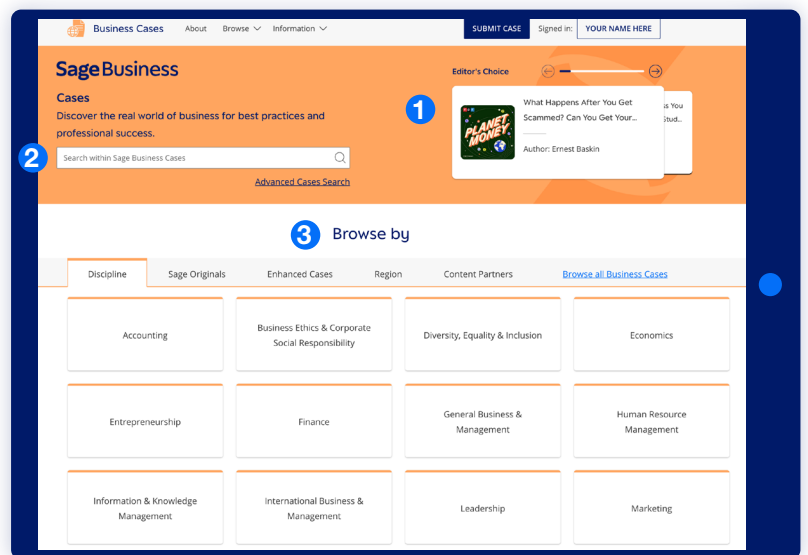

Access Teaching Notes

Once you have added an instructor verification code to your personal profile, you will be able to access teaching notes within Sage Business Cases. Content within teaching notes include suggested teaching strategies, discussion questions, analysis of discussion questions, links to web resources and further reading, bibliographies, and more.
